Approved 23 qualifying residents for the 2026 assessment freeze program (taxes payable in 2027).

Disabled Veterans Property Tax Exemption

Approved 22 qualifying residents for the 2026 exemption program (taxes payable in 2027).

Tax Exempt Properties

Approved the annual list of qualifying tax-exempt properties for 2026 taxes payable in 2027.

Valuation and Reclassification Requests

Multiple valuation adjustments and reclassification requests were reviewed and acted upon by the Board of Equalization. Approved reductions were granted where incorrect valuations were identified, while several reclassification requests were denied due to planning and zoning requirements or existing covenants.
